

## What Happens during a Davis Consultation?

A Davis consultation is designed to understand **how the individual is experiencing learning**, rather than to diagnose or label. It provides clarity, direction, and a personalised recommendation for next steps.

While all consultations share the same foundation, the **structure differs slightly depending on the area of need**.

### Dyslexia, AD/HD and Dyscalculia (maths) Consultations

These consultations are typically **around 2 hours** and involve both the **parent/s / guardian and the learner**.

#### During the consultation, we will:

- Explore the individual's **strengths, challenges, and learning experiences**
- Discuss how they currently approach reading, writing, maths, or attention
- Identify signs of **confusion and disorientation**, and how these may be affecting performance
- Introduce key **Davis concepts and tools** in a simple, practical way
- Observe how the learner responds to these ideas in real time

This is not a test. It is an opportunity to see **how the learner thinks and processes information**.

#### By the end of the session:

- You will have a clear understanding of **what may be causing the difficulties**
- I will recommend whether a **Davis programme is appropriate**
- If so, I will outline a **tailored programme plan**, including structure, timing, and next steps

### Autism (Davis Autism Approach®) Consultation

The consultation process for autism is **intentionally different**, as it focuses first on the **parent's understanding and readiness**, rather than immediate work with the child.

#### Step 1: Parent Consultation (1–2 hours)

- A detailed discussion about your child's **development, communication, and experiences**
- A clear explanation of the **Davis Autism Approach®**, including how it differs from other interventions
- Exploration of whether this approach feels like the **right fit for your child and family**

#### Step 2: Child "Meet & Greet" (30–45 minutes, no charge)

- A gentle, informal introduction between myself and your child
- No demands, no assessment—simply an opportunity to observe **comfort, connection, and readiness**
- Ensures the programme is **mutually appropriate** before moving forward

#### The Purpose of the Consultation

Across all areas, the consultation is about:

- Gaining **clarity**, not applying labels
- Understanding the **root of the difficulty**, not just the symptoms
- Ensuring the approach is **appropriate, personalised, and collaborative**

### Moving Forward

If a Davis programme is recommended, you will leave with a clear, structured pathway. If not, you will still gain valuable insight into how your child learns and what may support them best.
